The Canadian Institute for Child & Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy (CICAPP) provides training in the theory and technique of psychotherapy for professionals working with children and adolescents. Graduates are trained to assess for normal functioning, psychopathology and dysfunction, and to conduct psychotherapy when indicated. The training qualifies graduates to consult, supervise, and teach in agencies concerned with child and adolescent mental health. CICAPP is accredited with and meets all the standards and requirements of the College of Registered Psychotherapists (CRPO), the regulatory body for all practicing psychotherapists in Ontario. The four-year CICAPP program combines academic study with supervised clinical work. CICAPP is a post-professional training program, specializing in children and adolescents. Candidates have an undergraduate degree, typically in the social sciences and health services; most are professionals obtaining additional training to specialize in working with children and adolescent psychotherapy. CICAPP provides an equivalency to a Masters program or higher level of training. To complete the CICAPP training program, all candidates must complete a number of assessment and training cases covering a wide range of client issues and ages. All students must complete over 450 hours of direct client contact work, as well as over 200 supervisory sessions. Candidates are supervised on a weekly basis by formally trained members of CICAPP faculty. Candidate training cases are reviewed regularly by the Student Progress Committee at CICAPP as well as individual case supervisors. All candidates are insured for professional liability.
